



The Animal Health Foundation of Oregon (formerly the Oregon Animal Health Foundation) was established in 1983 by the Oregon Veterinary Medical Association to promote the health and welfare of animals by supporting a variety of educational and scientific programs and projects:

► **Disaster Preparedness:** Raised over \$31,000 to support veterinary-based relief efforts after Hurricane Katrina. Supported statewide efforts to create community-based disaster preparedness plans through the publication of guidelines for such efforts, which were distributed to all counties. Conducted statewide disaster preparedness workshops, including the DVM's role.

► **Animal Welfare:** Active in educating veterinarians and the public on animal welfare issues, including animal abuse and neglect. Published a booklet for all OVMA members on the veterinarian's role in the recognition and documentation of animal abuse. Sponsor of the Animal Welfare track at the Oregon Veterinary Conference, with topics including animal neglect and abuse, equine abandonment and welfare, and the human-animal bond. At the 2017 OVC, we will sponsor a presentation and debate on animal welfare issues with Dr. Gail Golab (AVMA) and Wayne Pacelle (HSUS).

► **Human-Animal Bond:** Among other programs, we are honored to be a co-sponsor (with the OVMA) of the Oregon Animal Hall of Fame™, which honors animals who exemplify the value of the human-animal bond.
